INFORMATION

The Illinois Royal Rangers Winter Camp is a nice, easy, fun outing, especially for the boys and their Leaders. Instead of sleeping outside in tents, we sleep in heated cabins. Meals are provided and served to you except for late night snakes. There are plenty of organized and informal winter activities for the boys. To top off each day, a premier speaker highlights the evening rallies. Held on the spacious grounds of Lake Geneva Conference Center, W2655 W. Send your registration fees early to reserve space! Your **registration must be completed online by December 27, 2023**. A minimum deposit of \$75.00 per camper is due at the time of registration in order to get a cabin assignment. The full amount due by camp.

REGISTRATION

Reservations are made only when the minimum registration fee is received. **(Registration money cannot be refunded for cancellations after December 27th)** Cabins will be assigned in the order in which the group's registration fee is received. All boys are required to be accompanied by an adult male group leader. To register, simply go online to <https://ilrr.churchcenter.com/registrations> and register each per person and pay by credit card or Apple pay, then send the included form to Paul. If paying by check complete the online registration, then fill out the attached registration form and pay in full to **Paul Nottingham, 1325 Lake Drive Morris, IL 60450 ptnott@att.net**. Please indicate your cabin preference, with your registration. The price for this year's Winter Camp is **\$150.00** for members of chartered Royal Rangers outposts and **\$170.00** for non-Rangers and members of outposts that are not chartered. Only Outposts chartered for 2023-24 are eligible for the discount. **Be sure to charter on-line with the National Royal Rangers office to be eligible for the 15% Discount!**



After you have paid your registration fees a confirmation will be sent via email to Outpost Coordinator, or group leader designated on the online registration. Registration is handled on a first come first served basis. There is only one camp this year, so it fills quickly. Register online early!

ACCOMMODATIONS

Each cabin is equipped with bunk beds and mattresses. Every person must bring their own sleeping bag or sheets, blankets and a pillow. Each group will be assigned a cabin or dorm with their indicated preference taken into consideration. Some groups may need to share cabin space with another group. Modern bathrooms and shower facilities are provided for each group of cabins. Bathrooms are adjoining to the rooms.



MEALS

The food at Camp LGYC is one of the highlights of Winter Camp ... it is great! And, there will be plenty of food, so nobody goes hungry. The meals provided will include breakfast, lunch, and dinner on Saturday; Saturday night snack (pizza) and breakfast on Sunday.

SERVICES AND RALLIES

A special evening rally will be featured both Friday and Saturday nights. There will also be a Sunday morning service. Winter Camp is a unique time of ministry. Unlike most Royal Ranger outings where there may not be comfortable conditions for the boys to hear and respond to the gospel message, the services at Winter Camp are held in a warm, rustic, and comfortable building. The altar services at Winter Camp are special times of ministry. Our Special Speaker and storyteller will challenge every camper in their walk with Christ. Make sure that YOUR Pastor counts you as present and being in a Sunday morning service. **Campers are REQUIRED to attend services.** Dads and leaders, this sets a good example for the boys by attending every service available. After a long day of winter activities, the younger boys may be too tired to attend the Saturday evening service.

ACTIVITIES

The camp has some snow-making equipment for one area of the camp in the event the weather is not cooperating. There are nice hills for sledding, and a toboggan chute. Boys can bring their own sleds. There will be plenty of indoor and outdoor activities provided including *Modern Indoor Gym, Indoor floor hockey, Archery tag, Rec room, Tubing (weather permitting) and more!*

INSURANCE

Generally, each individual's medical insurance would cover them at this event. Secondary insurance, which is usually the church's insurance, should be provided for each group. Any medical costs incurred by a boy or leader are first billed to the individual, then to his church. **HAVE THE PASTOR SIGN ON THE REGISTRATION FORM THAT THE CHURCH HAS SECONDARY INSURANCE.**

From Chicago and Vicinity

Route #1

Take I-94 West toward Milwaukee and exit at Hwy 50 (just past the IL/WI border). Go West on Hwy 50 to Lake Geneva (26 miles). Turn left onto Hwy 120 (Edwards Blvd.) at the Wal-Mart. Proceed on 120 for about a mile then turn right onto Bloomfield Rd. Continue straight ahead through the 4 way stop, Bloomfield Rd. becomes South Street. Campers attending LGYC summer programs, turn left at Gate 7 and Guest Groups using the Conference Center, turn left at Gate 3 and proceed to the gym parking lot.

Route #2

Take Hwy 12 West into WI and exit at Hwy 50/120/H exit. Go West on Hwy 50. Turn left onto Hwy 120. See Route # 1 for remaining directions.

Route #3

Take I-90 West toward Rockford and exit at IL Hwy 47 and proceed north. Hwy 47 becomes WI Hwy 120 at the IL/WI border. Continue on Hwy 120 for about 3.5 miles until the 4 way stop. Proceed straight ahead on BB for about 1 mile. When BB turns left stay in the right lane (becomes South Lake Shore Dr.). Continue on S.L.S.D. for about a mile then turn right onto South Street. Guest Groups using the turn right Gate 3 and proceed to the gym parking lot. Campers attending LGYC summer programs turn right at Gate 7. Guest Groups using the Conference Center turn left at Gate 3 and proceed to the gym parking lot.

LGF RELEASE, INDEMNIFICATION AND HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT, rev. 6-3-17

In consideration of participating in activities, and for other good and valuable consideration, I hereby agree to **release and discharge from liability** arising from negligence *Lake Geneva Foundation, Lake Geneva Youth Camp and Conference Point Center* and its owners, directors, officers employees, agents, volunteers, participants, and all other persons or entities acting for them (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Releasees"), on behalf of myself and my children, parents, heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate, and also agree as follows:

1. I acknowledge that participating in any physical activity including, but not limited to, walking, running, hiking, basketball, volleyball, sand volleyball, soccer, dodgeball, human foosball, gaga ball, 9 square in the air, shuffle board, tether ball, playground equipment, floor hockey, broom ball, disc golf, horseshoes, fishing, tennis, softball, bocce ball, campfires, field games, any activity in the gym, game room, or any activity my group orchestrates while on property or any of the staffed elements including, but not limited to, archery, boat rides, banana boating, tubing (water and snow), waterskiing, wakeboarding, swimming, canoeing, paddle boating, kayaking, climbing wall, giant swing, mountain biking, paintball, teams course/challenge course, toboggan run, waterslide, zip line, zorb ball, and laser tag, involves known and unanticipated risks which could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis or permanent disability, death, and property damage. Risks include, but are not limited to, broken bones, torn ligaments, or other injuries as a result of falls or contact with other participants, insect bites (spiders, ticks, bed bugs, mosquitoes, etc.); death as a result of drowning or brain damage caused by near drowning in lakes or other bodies of water; medical conditions resulting from physical activity; and damaged clothing or other property. I understand such risks simply cannot be eliminated, despite the use of safety equipment, without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity.
2. **I expressly accept and assume all of the risks inherent in this activity or that might have been caused by the negligence of the Releasees.** My participation in this activity is purely voluntary and I elect to participate despite the risks. In addition, if at any time I believe that event conditions are unsafe or that I am unable to participate due to physical or medical conditions, then I will immediately discontinue participation.
3. **I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless Releasees from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action which are in any way connected with my participation in this activity, or my use of their equipment or facilities, arising from negligence. This release does not apply to claims arising from intentional conduct.** Should Releasees or anyone acting on their behalf be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs.
4. I represent that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I may suffer or cause while participating in this activity, or else I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage myself. I further represent that I have no medical or physical condition which could interfere with my safety in this activity, or else I am willing to assume – and bear the costs of – all risks that may be created, directly or indirectly, by any such condition.
5. In the event that I file a lawsuit, I agree to do so in the state where Releasees' facility is located, and I further agree that the substantive law of that state shall apply.
6. I agree that if any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

By signing this document, I agree that if I am hurt or my property is damaged during my participation in this activity, then I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against the parties being released on the basis of any claim for negligence.

Assumption of the Risk and Waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. Lake Geneva Foundation, Lake Geneva Youth Camp, and Conference Point Center collectively known as "LGF" has put in place preventative measures to reduce the

spread of COVID-19; however, **LGF cannot guarantee that you will not become infected with COVID-19.** Further, participation could increase your risk of contracting COVID-19.

READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING

By signing this agreement, **I acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume the risk that I may be exposed to or infected by COVID-19 by participation; and that such exposure or infection may result in personal injury, illness, permanent disability, and death.** I understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at LGF may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of myself and others, including, but not limited to, LGF's employees, volunteers, and program participants and their families.

I voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to myself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that I may experience or incur in connection with my participation at LGF. On my behalf, I hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless LGF, its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs, or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. I understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of LGF, its employees, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation at LGF.

I have had sufficient time to read this entire document and, should I choose to do so, consult with legal counsel prior to signing. Also, I understand that this activity might not be made available to me or that the cost to engage in this activity would be significantly greater if I were to choose not to sign this release and agree that the opportunity to participate at the stated cost in return for the execution of this release is a reasonable bargain. **I have read and understood this document and I agree to be bound by its terms.**

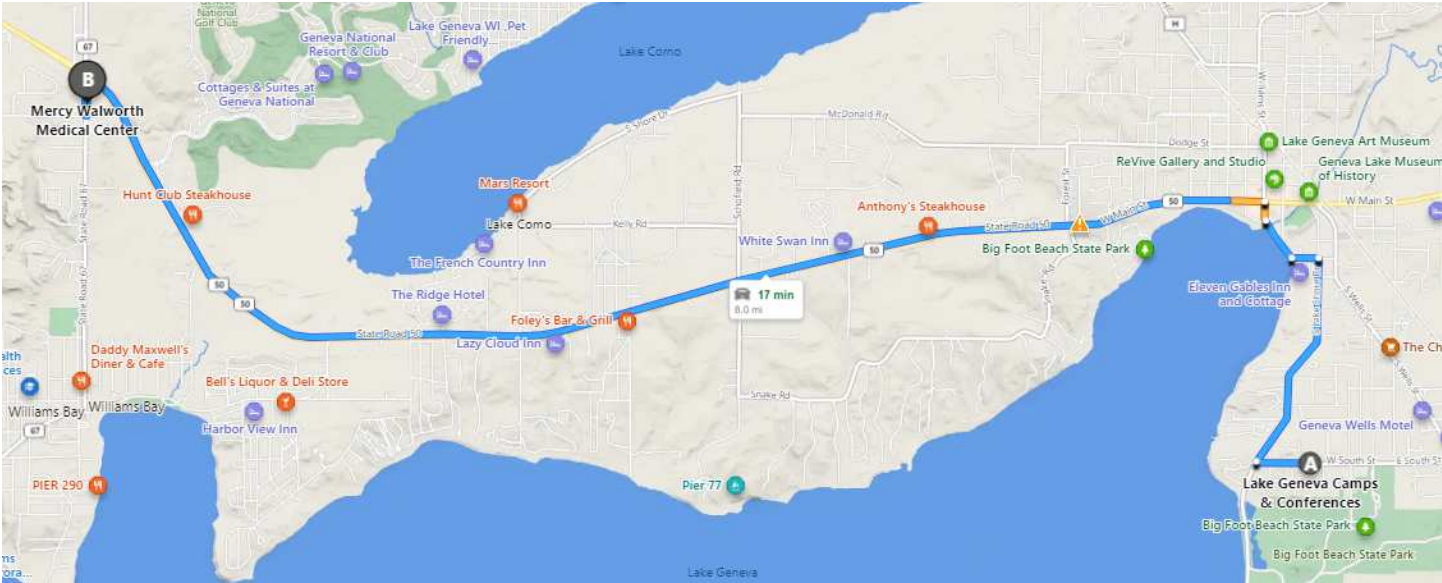
